Old Course Hotel Golf Resort & Spa

Bordering the renowned 17th Road Hole of the Old Course, the Old Course Hotel overlooks the famous links courses, the West Sands Beach and the beautiful Scottish coastline. This prestigious AA Five Star-awarded hotel has 144 rooms including 35 suites and is recognized as one of Europe's leading resorts. Located just a short stroll from the historic University town of St Andrews, the hotel is in a great location for golfers and non-golfers alike.



St Andrews Eden Course

The St Andrews Eden Course was built in 1914 by Harry Colt, with assistance from Alister McKenzie. They superbly utilised the natural features and partially buried field boundary dykes to create a stunning links course neighbouring St Andrews Old Course. Not the longest of the Links Trust courses at 5,869 yards but don't let this fool you. When the wind is up, the Eden is extremely tricky to master, especially with its fast, undulating greens meaning placement is key on your approach shots.



St Andrews New Course

The oldest "new" course in the world, the second course at the "Home of Golf" was built by the Keeper of the Green, Tom Morris, in 1895 and it was imaginatively named to differentiate it from its famous neighbour. It has frequently been said that if the New Course were not situated next to the Old, then its star would have shone with a far greater degree of brilliance. Located as it is in the shadow of its illustrious neighbour, the New Course can be considered one of St Andrews' best-kept secrets, boasting undulating fairways and challenging greens - a classic test of links golf!

St Andrews Jubilee Course

The third championship course at the "Home of Golf", the Jubilee is considered by many to be the most challenging course on the famous Links. Built in 1897, it was originally a 12-hole layout intended for use by ladies and beginners. However, after seeing its prime golfing location between the New Course and the sea, the Jubilee was converted to a championship course in 1988.



St Andrews Old Course

The oldest golf course in the world has many remarkable features which help make it so special to golfers around the world. It is the "Home of Golf" where golf was first played 600 years ago and yet it still remains a real test for amateur and professional golfers alike. The Swilcan Bridge, Hell Bunker and Valley of Sin are recognised across the globe. GHW Golf Tours are an official Authorised Provider (look out for the logo) of St Andrews Old Course. A Guaranteed St Andrews Old Course Package must include a minimum of four nights accommodation, two rounds of golf and private airport and golf transfers.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT & RULES

FORMAT

- 72 Hole individual stableford
- ¾ Handicap allowance
- Point Scoring: Net Par: 2 points / Net Birdie: 3 points / Net Eagle: 4 points / Net Bogey: 1 point
- Net Double Bogey or Others: NO POINTS
- The 4 Rounds will be considered to determine the overall winner
- No mulligan's or gimmy's are permitted; all the balls must be holed
- If no points can be made on a hole it is advisable to pick-up for "speed of play"

RULES

- R&A rules, the only exception being those areas where local rules apply
- If one or more rounds are suspended or cancelled, the tournament referee (Director) has the final say on scoring
- The tournament referee (Director) has the final say on all matters relating to the rules

TOURNAMENT HANDICAPS & CATEGORIES

Handicaps

- Official proof of handicap is required at registration from your home club
- Handicaps will be verified prior to the Scottish Golf Classic where possible
- Men's maximum handicap of 28
- Ladies maximum handicap of 36
- Each player will play from the corresponding tee-box at each particular course

Tournament Categories

- One category 0-36

DRESS CODE

- Normal golf attire is expected. Jeans are not acceptable. Some courses allow tailored shorts normally with long socks; if unsure please contact our office.

CADDIE FEES AND PAYMENTS

All caddies are licensed by St Andrews Links Trust but not employed. Payment should be made directly to the caddie on completion of your round in cash.

CADDIE FEES: £65.00 + gratuity

FORECADDIE FEES: 2 golfers £100.00 + gratuity
3 golfers £120.00 + gratuity
4 golfers £140.00 + gratuity

GRATUITY POLICY

A gratuity or tip is entirely at the discretion of the golfer and should be based on the level of service provided. If you feel the service received has been exceptional and the caddie has enhanced your round the gratuity should reflect this. As a guide, gratuity generally starts at £25.00

INDIVIDUAL CADDIE

Caddies are assigned to work for a specific player and will carry one bag only. They are responsible for all caddie duties on the golf course.

FORECADDIES

Forecaddies will offer a shared service, meaning the experience provided by the caddie to a group of golfers differs. A forecaddie will provide historical information and stories, lines off tees, approach yardages into the greens and read golfers putts when possible.

DEFINITION OF 'TRANSFERS'

This means Point A to Point B and return.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE:

- 50% Non-refundable deposit payment at time of booking
- 50% or Remaining balance due 16 weeks prior to departure/arrival

GOLF TOUR EXCLUDES:

- Air fares
- Travel Insurance (we strongly advise you obtain travel/cancellation insurance for your golf tour)
- Caddies, equipment hire, golf accessories
- Gratuities
- Lunch/dinner unless stipulated
- Any items of a personal nature

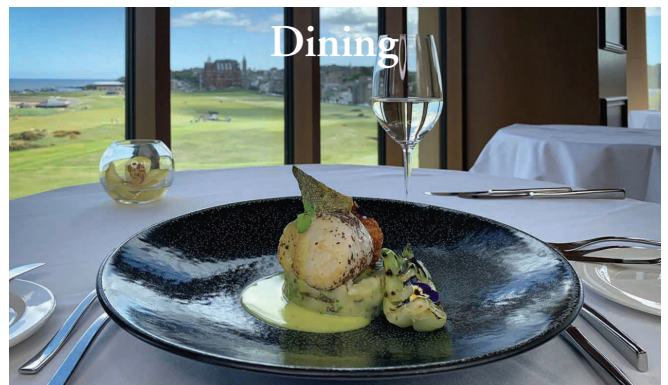
